“So you are a traditional student and would like to enroll in an online course at Morthland College. Now what?”

-
- Upon request, your academic advisor will let you know what online courses are available to you each semester.
 - In order to be a full time student and receive full financial aid, you must be enrolled in twelve (12) credit hours that begin and end during the traditional student calendar.
 - Therefore, since online courses begin the first day of every other month, in order to receive Financial Aid for the online course, you must enroll in a course that begins on September 1 or March 1.
 - You may only take one online course per semester. Exemptions can only be approved by your Department Chair and the Provost. You can take no more than two online courses per semester.
 - You MAY take any online course; however, any courses that start prior to or end after the traditional calendar dates will need to be ‘self-pay’ and will not count towards the Federal Aid definition of full time.
 - Additional fees may apply to the online course.
